

National Taiwan Normal University Guidelines for the Establishment of the Intellectual Property Rights Promotion and Implementation Work Group

Passed during the 331st Administrative Meeting on March 23, 2011

First amendment passed during the 343rd Administrative Meeting on March 19, 2024

Second amendment passed during the 5th Administrative Meeting on March 4, 2015

- I. National Taiwan Normal University established the Intellectual Property Rights Promotion and Implementation Work Group (hereinafter referred to as the “Work Group”) to actively promote and implement intellectual property rights protection on campus.
- II. The Work Group has the following missions:
 - (I) Promote laws and regulations and plan activities on campus related to intellectual property rights.
 - (II) Formulate policies related to the protection of intellectual property rights on campus.
 - (III) Plan and implement of other measures to protect intellectual property rights on campus.
- III. The Work Group has several members, including the executive vice president, secretary general, vice president for academic affairs, vice president for student affairs, vice president for general affairs, vice president for research and development, vice president for Office of International Affairs, university librarian, director of the Information Technology Center, and representatives of the Student Association. The executive vice president serves as the convener.
- IV. The director of the Information Technology Center serves as the Work Group’s executive secretary and handles matters related to the Work Group.
- V. The Work Group convenes at least once per academic year, and may convene whenever deemed necessary. Personnel from relevant units may be invited to attend meetings in a non-voting capacity.
- VI. These Guidelines have been implemented after approval by an Administrative Meeting. The same shall apply to all subsequent amendments.
